#### **Selected Project Experience**

- Yangon HMA Residence, Refurbishment including Seismic Strengthening Kirsty was involved in the seismic assessment of the HMA Residence and the development of the structural works required to strengthen the existing building so that they work sympathetically with the historic building. She has also during the construction phase working with a local contractor to ensure that the works are carried out as per the design.
- Bogota HMA Residence, Refurbishment including Seismic Strengthening Kirsty worked alongside the local consultant to develop a structural scheme to strengthen the historic residence which could be submitted to the local conversation office and planning department for approvals with minimal opening up works. Once on site Kirsty worked with a regional contractor to ensure that the details were understood and the structural strengthening was installed correctly. Due to COVID-19 this project has been paused during the construction phase.
- Anguilla Governor's Residence, New Build

Following damage in the Hurricane Irma in 2017 the Governor of Anguilla vacated the residence and a new Residence was to be constructed in its place. Kirsty worked alongside FCOS in house design team to develop the proposals for a new residence to Stage 3. She carried out an initial scheme design and prepared the structural drawings.
